ALL GEAR must be labeled with the letter designating your son's group (N for Navajo; E for Eclipse) a dash (-), then his initials in a location easily found (inside waistbands, collars, et cetera – but not on tags, they can be torn out) with a permanent laundry marker. For example, John Doe in the Navajo Group would mark his gear "N-JD".

ALL reading material must have parental and staff approval. Cotton/cotton blend clothing is preferred except as noted. It breathes better and synthetics are more flammable. We realize some students may require special personal care products not listed. Ask your group's supervisor if you have any questions.
