For example, <u>John Doe in the Navajo Group would mark his gear "N-JD"</u>.

ALL reading material must have parental and staff approval. Cotton/cotton blend clothing is preferred except as noted. It breathes better and synthetics are more flammable. We realize some students may require special personal care products not listed. Ask your group's supervisor if you have any questions.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED

- Items (clothing and non-clothing) advertising tobacco, alcohol products, drugs, violence, sex, profanity, satanic/occult products or ideas, suicide, racial discrimination, nudity or pornography
- NO Clothing that is unfastened, marked up, or ripped, and clothes worn backwards or inside out
- NO Pants that are oversized, extra long or sagging
- NO body piercings
- Students are discouraged from bringing valuable or sentimental items, as de la Howe WILL NOT BE responsible for missing, lost, stolen or damaged items
- If your child has existing tattoos, they must be covered at all times with clothing OR Band-Aids. Parents WILL BE responsible for covering up tattoos
- NO Cameras (digital or disposable)
- NO Alarm Clocks ONLY ALLOWED
- NO CELL PHONES, chargers or pagers
- NO ITEMS ALLOWED that promote gang involvement
- NO CARGO PANTS/SHORTS
- NO HOODED JACKETS, COATS OR SWEATSHIRTS
- NO BANDANNAS
- NO excessive jewelry
- NO FOOD/SNACKS
- NO MP3 Players
- NO white out correct fluid or permanent markers
- NO Hair Clippers
